New Canadian light vehicle sales record for the month of August

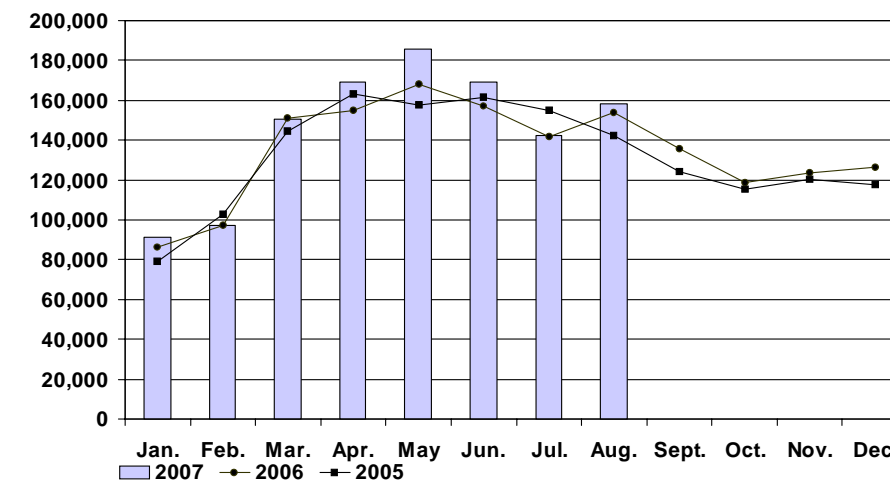
Canadian light vehicle sales established a new record for the month of August as 158,394 units were delivered to consumers. Sales were up 3.1% over August 2006 when 153,637 light vehicles were sold. Modest growth occurred in both the light truck (+4.2%) and passenger car (+2.2%) segments. Light truck volume climbed 2,980 units over the previous year as 74,373 units were purchased in August. Passenger car sales reached 84,021 units, inching up

1,777 units compared to last year. In the first eight months of this year, sales are up 4.7% as 1.2 million light vehicles have been added to Canadian roads. Both light truck (+7.7%) and passenger car (+2.2%) volume has increased thus far. Light truck market share continued its upward trend inching up 1.3 points to settle at 47.1%.

Double-digit increases in August year-over-year sales were reported at Mitsubishi (+47.3%), Kia (+31.3%), Land Rover (+29.0%), Suzuki (+26.0%), Porsche (+19.7%), and MINI (+19.0%). Mitsubishi and Suzuki

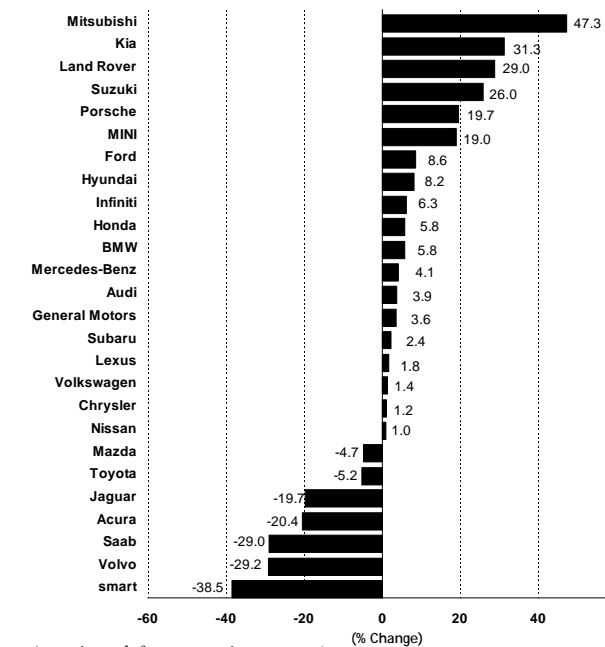

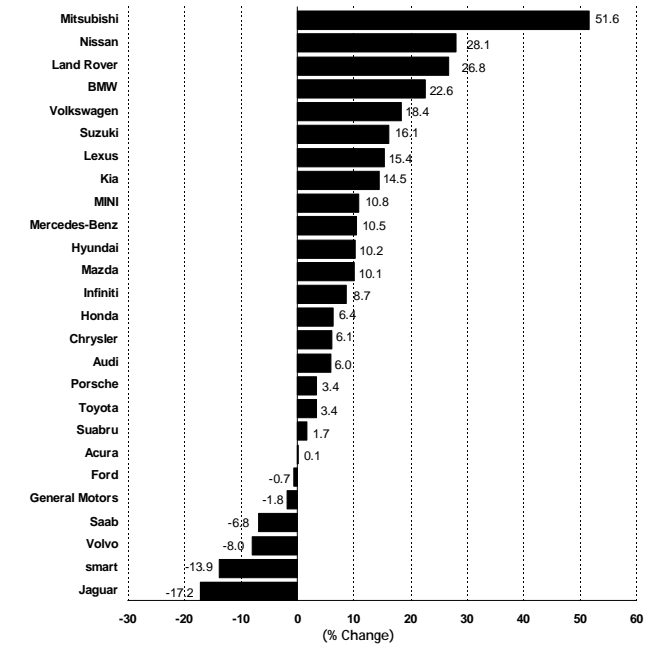
Total Canadian Light Vehicle Sales % Change August 2007 vs. August 2006

confirmed double-digit gains in both passenger car and light truck sales. Kia posted an impressive 62.5% improvement in passenger car volume, while Porsche experienced a 56.9% surge in Cayenne SUV sales. All six manufacturers listed above have confirmed heightened year-to-date sales thus far. Moderate increases in August sales were witnessed by Ford (+8.6%), Hyundai (+8.2%), Infiniti (+6.3%), Honda (+5.8%), BMW (+5.8%), Mercedes-Benz (+4.1%), Audi (+3.9%), and General Motors (+3.6%). Only BMW and General Motors recorded gains in both light truck and passenger car sales. Audi recorded significant growth sales of the Q7 SUV

(+139.5%). Ford (-0.7%) and General Motors (-1.8%) were the only manufacturers mentioned above to report reduced sales between January and August. A slight rise in light vehicle sales was evident for Subaru (+2.4%), Lexus (+1.8%), Volkswagen (+1.4%), Chrysler (+1.2%), and Nissan (+1.0%). Double-digit growth in passenger car sales occurred at Nissan (+30.4%), Lexus (+24.8%), and Subaru (+16.1%). Sales of the recently redesigned Volkswagen Touareg SUV surged 39.3% compared to August 2006 as 85 units were purchased. The Touareg recently received its first major redesign since its launch in 2003. In year-to-date volume, all five manufacturers sit above 2006's sales pace.

Reduced sales volume was experienced at Mazda (-4.7%), and Toyota (-5.2%) while Jaguar (-19.7%), Acura (-20.4%), Saab (-29.0%), Volvo (-29.2%), and smart (-38.5%) suffered the largest reductions. Toyota (+18.2%), Acura (+17.1%), and Mazda (+10.8%) confirmed heightened light truck sales but could not offset a drop-off in passenger car volume. Both Saab and Volvo reported double-digit tumbles in passenger car and light truck sales. Heightened sales in the first eight months of 2007 were evident for Mazda (+10.1%), and Toyota (+3.4%) while year-to-date volume remained at relative par for Acura (+0.1%). Year-to-date, Saab (-6.8%), Volvo (-8.0%), and Jaguar (-17.2%) have reported declined sales thus far. **DAR**

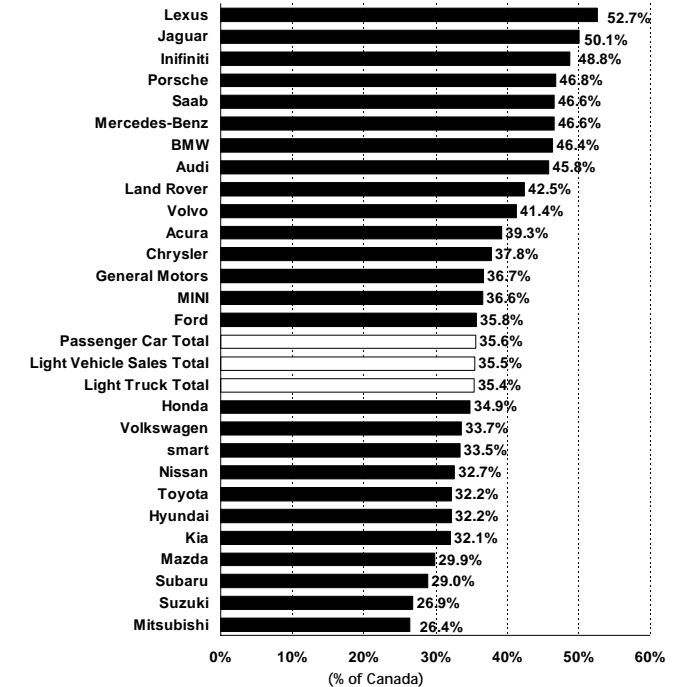
Quebec

Light vehicle sales in Quebec witnessed an 8.2% rise in volume as 219,709 units were sold in the first half of 2007. Much of the growth was fuelled by an upturn in light truck sales (+14.2%) with 78,171 units purchased. Passenger car volume rose a modest 5.1% as 141,538 units were delivered to consumers. Improved sales were evident at Mitsubishi (+60.2%), Nissan (+40.9%), Chrysler (+27.1%), Volkswagen (+26.3%), Land Rover (+20.1%), and Lexus (+20.0%).

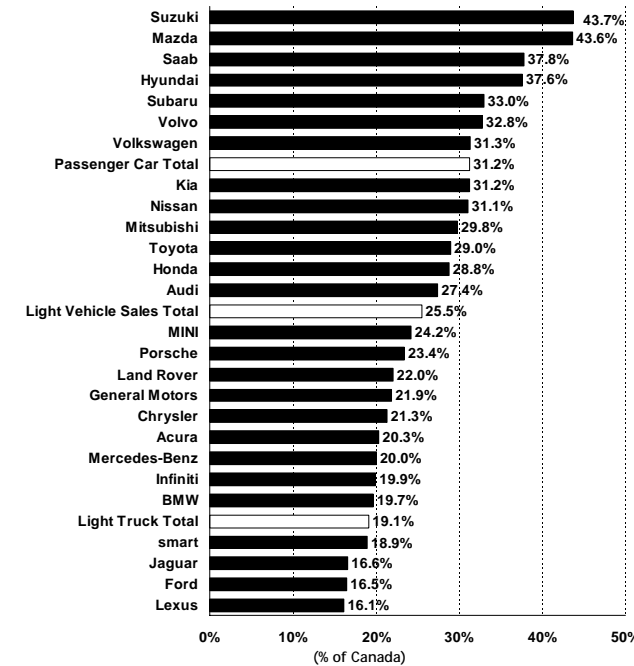
Atlantic

Light vehicle sales across the Atlantic Provinces climbed 8.8% in the first-half of 2007 with 61,984 units sold. A 15.7% surge in light truck volume led to much of the growth as 26,089 units were purchased. Passenger car sales rose a modest 4.3% settling at 35,895 units. BMW (+55.7%), Nissan (+48.7%), Mitsubishi (+35.8%), Suzuki (+30.6%), Mazda (+23.5%), and Hyundai (+23.0%) recorded the highest year-over-year percentage gains for the first half of 2007. **DAR**

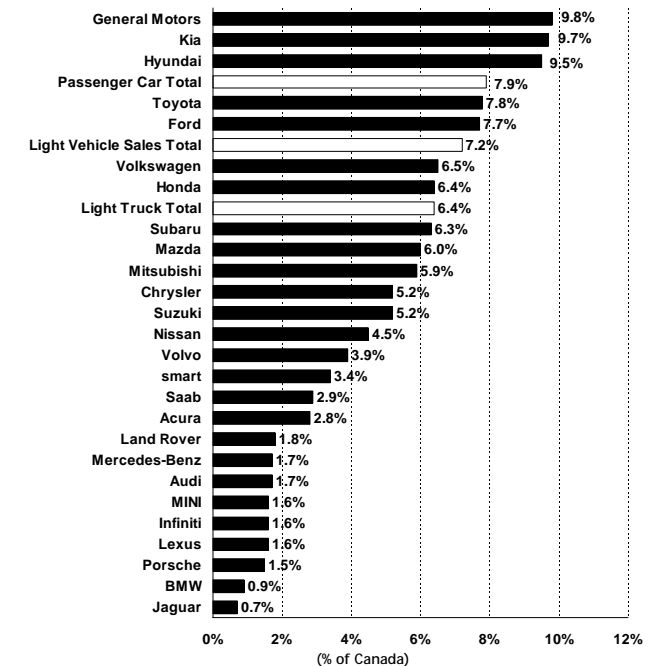
Share of Company's Light Vehicle Sales in Ontario - 1H 2007

British Columbia

By the end of the first half of 2007, year-over-year light vehicle sales in British Columbia climbed 7.9% reaching 101,915 units. Light truck sales shot up 13.4%, an increase of 6,035 units over the previous year. Passenger car volume witnessed a slight increase of 2.8% as sales reached 51,007 units. Eighteen of twenty-six manufacturers confirmed heightened sales volume at the end of June. Mitsubishi recorded the highest year-over-year growth as sales surged 100.6%. Impressive double-digit growth was evident for Nissan (+52.6%), Volkswagen (+31.6%), Kia (+27.4%), BMW (+27.0%), and Land Rover (+26.9%). Thus far, British Columbia holds 11.8% of all light vehicles sold in Canada.

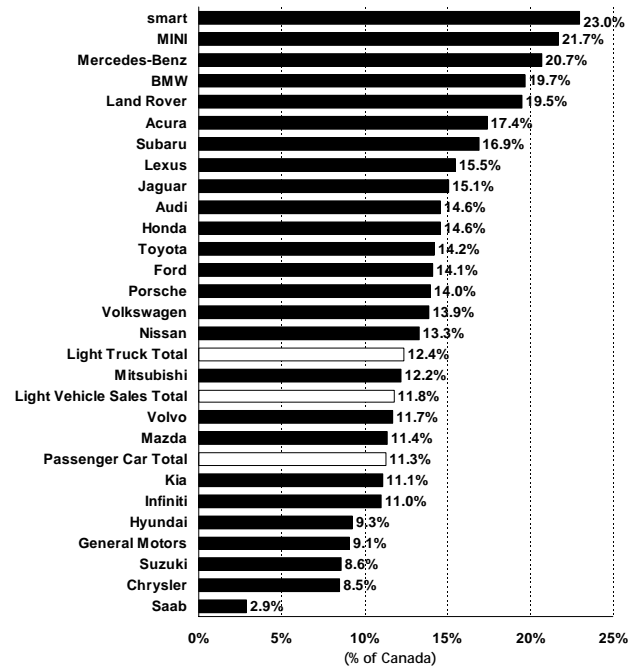
Prairies

Between January and June, 172,882 light vehicles were purchased in the Prairie Provinces of Canada, a 10.1% improvement over 2006's 157,072 units. Light truck volume moved up an impressive 13.0% with 109,279 units sold during the first six months of 2007. A 5.4% rise was evident for passenger car sales as 63,603 units were delivered to consumers. Significant growth was achieved at Mercedes-Benz (+58.1%), Hyundai (+55.5%), Nissan (+46.9%), and Mitsubishi (+43.7%). Only five of the twenty-six manufacturers confirmed reduced sales in the first half of 2007 - Porsche (-0.6%), Chrysler (-0.7%), Jaguar (-4.9%), Volvo (-5.7%), and smart (-8.2%).

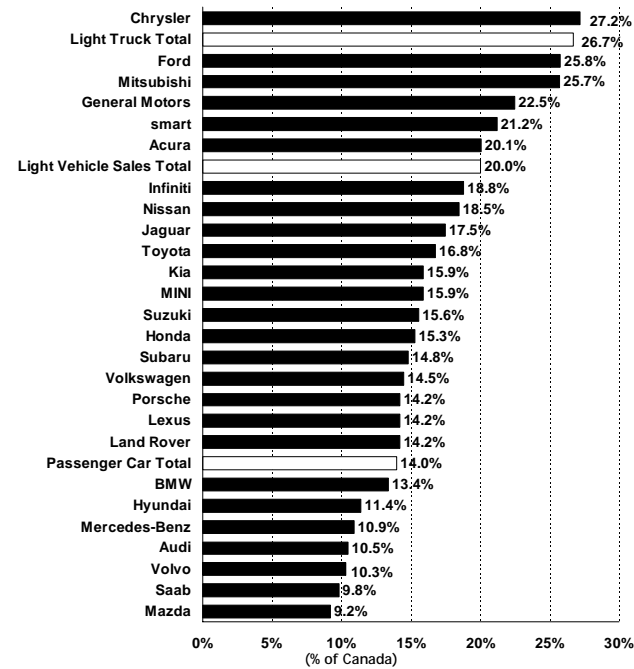
Ontario

First-half light vehicle sales in Ontario grew slightly by 0.7% as a 3.5% spurt in light truck volume was able to offset a 1.6% dip in passenger car volume. Light truck sales reached 144,983 units while passenger car purchases fell to 161,116 units. By the end of June, 306,099 light vehicles were purchased in Ontario, accounting for 35.5% of total Canadian light vehicle sales, the highest share of all the regions. The largest year-over-year gains were made by Mitsubishi (+38.5%), Land Rover (+27.3%), BMW (+25.8%), Nissan (+24.9%), and Volkswagen (+20.7%). The largest declines were revealed at Volvo (-10.2%), Subaru (-12.7%), and Jaguar (-20.9%).

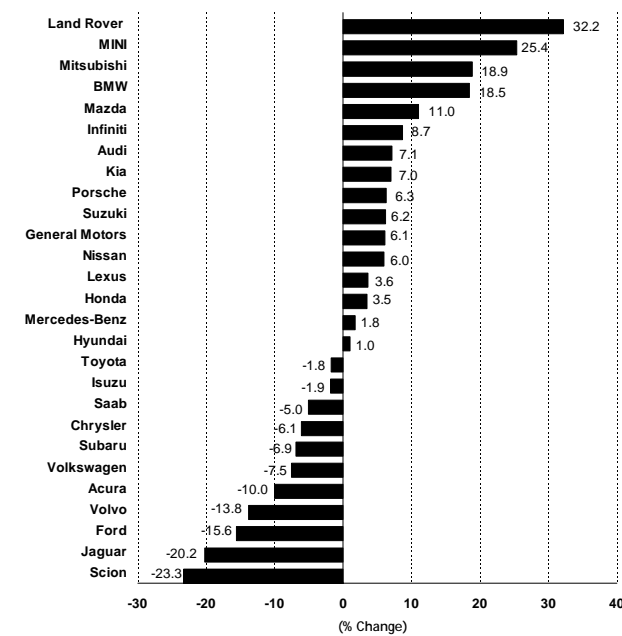
Share of Company's Light Vehicle Sales in British Columbia - 1H 2007



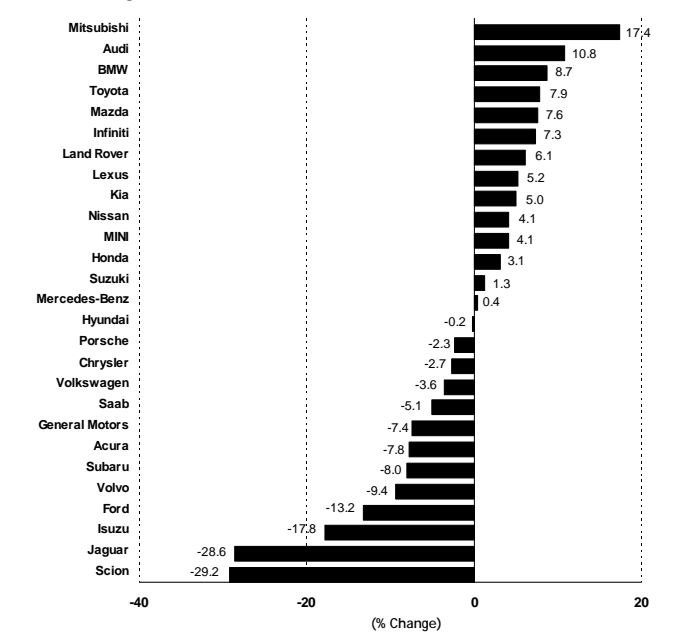
Share of Company's Light Vehicle Sales in Prairies - 1H 2007

U.S. light truck sales up 2.7% in August

Year-over-year light vehicle sales in the U.S. declined slightly by 1.0% as 1.5 million units were purchased in August, 14,115 fewer units compared to August 2006. Sales of light trucks were up 2.7% with 781,715 units delivered while passenger car volume fell a modest 4.8% settling at 686,400 units. Through the first eight months of 2007, light vehicle sales dipped 2.9% totalling 11.0 million units, 329,263 fewer units compared to the same period in 2006.

Double-digit gains in year-over-year sales in August were achieved at Land Rover (+32.2%), MINI (+25.4%), Mitsubishi (+18.9%), BMW (+18.5%), and Mazda (+11.0%). Mitsubishi obtained double-digit growth in both

light truck (+34.9%) and passenger car (+12.8%) volume. All five manufacturers mentioned above have reported enhanced year-to-date sales thus far.

Infiniti (+8.7%), Audi (+7.1%), Kia (+7.0%), Porsche (+6.3%), Suzuki (+6.2%), General Motors (+6.1%), and Nissan (+6.0%) confirmed heightened sales for the month of August. Growth in both the passenger car and light truck segments in August occurred at Infiniti, Porsche, and Nissan. Porsche (-2.3%) and General Motors (-7.4%) were the only manufacturers listed above to report fewer year-over-year sales between January and August.

Rounding out the manufacturers with heightened August sales are Lexus (+3.6%), Honda (+3.5%), Mercedes-

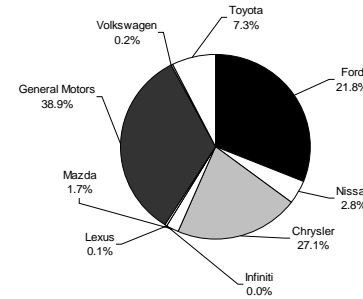
Benz (+1.8%), and Hyundai (+1.0%). Between January and August, Lexus (+5.2%), Honda (+3.1%), and Mercedes-Benz (+0.4%) recorded increased sales while Hyundai (-0.2%) suffered a dip in sales thus far.

Declines in August sales were apparent for Toyota (-1.8%), Isuzu (-1.9%), Saab (-5.0%), Chrysler (-6.1%), Subaru (-6.9%), and Volkswagen (-7.5%). Toyota (+7.9%) was the only manufacturer listed above to achieve growth in year-to-date sales.

Acura (-10.0%), Volvo (-13.8%), Ford (-15.6%), Jaguar (-20.2%), and Scion (-23.3%) suffered the largest fallbacks in August sales. Reduced year-to-date sales were confirmed by all five manufacturers listed above. **DAR**

First half 2007 Canadian fleet sales fell 9.6% compared to the previous year to 162,031 units, down from the 179,314 units in 2006. Passenger car volume was reduced 12.2% to 70,724 units. A 7.6% reduction was evident for light truck fleet sales with volume decreased to 91,307 units. Mazda (+36.5%) confirmed the largest year-over-year growth in fleet sales as they increased from 1,997 units in the first half of 2006 to 2,725 units in 2007. Much of the growth was led by heightened passenger car sales (+41.1%). Other manufacturers to reveal an increase in fleet sales volume include Lexus (+29.8%) and Nissan (+14.3%). Modest declines were experienced by Chrysler

(-4.3%), Toyota (-5.5%), General Motors (-11.5%), Volkswagen (-15.9%), and Ford (-17.6%) while Infiniti (-62.1%) and Audi (100.0%) fell the hardest.

First-half Canadian fleet sales market share reveal General Motors (38.9%), Chrysler (27.1%), and Ford (21.8%) as the top three. Chrysler obtained the largest rise in market share, gaining 1.5 points while Ford secured the largest reduction, falling 2.1 points compared to the previous year. Toyota (7.3%) increased market share by 0.3 points in the first half of 2007. Nissan and Mazda made up 2.8% and 1.7% of fleet sales respectively. Rounding out the remaining manufacturers, Volkswagen captured 0.2% of the market at the end of June while Lexus secured 0.1%. Infiniti and Saab hold negligible shares of Canadian fleet sales.

By province, Alberta (37.2%), British Columbia (34.2%), and Ontario (32.8%) recorded the highest levels of fleet sales. Provinces slightly below the national average of 31.4% include Nova Scotia (31.3%), Quebec (26.9%), Manitoba (25.6%), and

Newfoundland (25.3%). Saskatchewan (21.3%), New Brunswick (21.2%), and Prince Edward Island (12.7%) posted fleet sales well below the national average at the end of the first half of 2007. **DAR**
